Bem vindo(a)! Welcome to Coimbra and to the Faculty of Economics!

✓ 1. NOMINATION

Nomination period: from 1 January until 30 June.

Partner institutions may nominate students:

- 1) By e-mail, to dri.intstudy@uc.pt (full name of the student; e-mail address; period of studies; field of studies at the UC)
- 2) Directly, via EWP (for ERASMUS partners already working on EWP).

After receiving nominations students will get further information about application procedures.

Important:

◆ The information system of the University of Coimbra already supports the Erasmus Without Paper (EWP) nomination process and Learning Agreement services. Applicants nominated via EWP will get from the University of Coimbra a simplified information for registration in *InforEstudante*, our academic platform.

◆ For Beneficiary Module information (if the application is under the Erasmus+ program), students may get the dates of arrival and departure on the official web site https://www.uc.pt/en/academicos/regulamentos/calendario_2025_2026, **academic calendar 2025/26**.

Original documents will only be issued to the students upon their request after arrival.

◆ Please note that you must upload the copy of the European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) or Private Health Insurance.

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The **application procedure (online system)** at the University of Coimbra is **mandatory**. It should be done at <http://www.uc.pt/en/driic/estudantesIN/CandidatIN/>

♦ Additionally, and still during the application process you must submit on our platform (*inforEstudante*) ALL the necessary application forms (**including the ones from the home institution¹**).



Students coming within the **ERASMUS+, COIMBRA GROUP/SEN, EC2U and ICM** programmes:

MAY NOT BE CONSIDERED.

In case your home institution has its own forms, you should also upload them, as mentioned.

¹ Upload the forms on the platform (*inforEstudante*), point **Outra Ficha de Candidatura**



If, during application process, you skip this step and do not carry out this procedure, the remaining forms (mandatory at your home institution) that need to be signed can only be signed later on and upon your arrival.

Soon after, all the documents, including (both) **learning agreement(s)** will be available there (*inforEstudante* | **Versão Atual da Ficha de Candidatura**).

The **deadlines** for registration are:

1st semester (September 2025 – February 2026) and **full year**: **15th July 2025**

2nd semester (February 2026 – July 2026): **15th December 2025**

√ 3. Plan of studies / LEARNING AGREEMENT

THE WORKLOAD FOR ONE SEMESTER IS 30 ECTS. At FEUC we do not accept students with an incomplete Learning Agreement (without performing 30 ECTS).

You can either choose course units lectured at the 1st cycle of studies (in any of our 4 bachelor degrees) – <https://www.uc.pt/en/feuc/teaching>, or at the 2nd cycle of studies (**Masters in Economics, Sociology Management and International Relations (NB1)**) <https://www.uc.pt/en/feuc/eea/masters-degree-courses/>

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Regarding the **2nd cycle of studies**, only these four-degree courses are available for *incoming mobility students*, since all the other courses have restricted *numerus clausus*. Besides, **students registered at the 2nd cycle of studies at their home university will have priority on attendance** of 2nd cycle course units at FEUC. For the remaining 2nd cycle courses, some EXCEPTIONS may be considered, if previously requested and analysed by the corresponding coordination.

(NB1) *In order to be able to follow the course units belonging the Master's Degree in International Relations, incoming mobility students, **MUST, compulsory, be enrolled in the 2nd cycle of studies at their home institution.***

♦ At FEUC **ALL courses** are lectured in Portuguese, except the ones listed at *courses lectured in English 2025/2026* – https://www.uc.pt/site/assets/files/384634/list_courses_eng_25-26.pdf

♦ Course units lectured by another Faculty/Department at the UC

If you want to attend a **course unit lectured by another Faculty/Department within the University of Coimbra** this request has to be validated, in advance, by each respective coordinator (<https://www.uc.pt/en/iru/erasmus/faculty-departmental-mobility-coordinators/>). Please note that, **in this**

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case, you must complete the majority of course units from the study area of the agreement that you are using for your application.

For example, a student coming to FEUC, within an agreement signed in Economics, has to follow a minimum of 3 course units (18 ECTS, total, 6 ECTS/each) in order to be allowed to follow another two course units (12 ECTS, 6 ECTS/each) from the Faculty of Arts and Humanities.

The Portuguese Language course (6 ECTS) may be considered as an extra course unit, not included in the regular 30 ECTS.

√ 4. Language requirements

At FEUC courses are lectured in Portuguese, except the ones listed at ***Courses Lectured in English***.

Thus, we recommend the following language levels:

- Portuguese: B1 (min)
- English: B2 (min)

√ 5. PORTUGUESE Language course

This course unit, with (4) four different levels, is managed by FLUC (*Faculty of Arts and Humanities*).

It is lectured on a semester basis and worth 6 ECTS.

Since this is a very requested course unit, it is **COMPULSORY** to include it in the initial plan of studies/*Learning Agreement*.

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Students may change the level of the course unit firstly chosen upon arrival. However, students who decide to follow it later on (upon arrival, for instance) may have no further places available!

√ 6. Accommodation

✓ 8. Remarks

1. You may only apply within the ERASMUS+ programme, if an *ERASMUS+ bilateral agreement* between the UC and your home university has been signed (and stills valid) within the study areas taught at FEUC, as follows:
 - a. 041/Business and Administration: 0413/*Management and Administration*
 - b. 0311/*Economics*
 - c. 0312/*Political Sciences and Civics* (former International Relations)
 - d. 0314/*Sociology and Cultural Studies*
2. International students from non-partner or from partner Universities, who have already used their opportunity of exchange, have the new chance to study for one or two semesters at the University of Coimbra as a **FREE MOVER**.

3. **If you are not an European Citizen**, after receiving the acceptance documents, you need to contact the nearest Portuguese Consulate/Embassy of your city of residence. Inform yourself about the types of visa that apply to your case and how you should proceed to obtain it in the web portal of the Portuguese Communities Office.

Please note that without a (valid) VISA it will be impossible to register (after arrival) at the UC.

4. **European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) / Cartão Europeu do Seguro de Doença (CESD)**: be sure to make all arrangements to get your EHIC before arriving in Coimbra and start your mobility period
If you are not an European Citizen we strongly recommend you to do an Health insurance, valid for the host country (in this case, valid for Portugal), during your mobility period.
