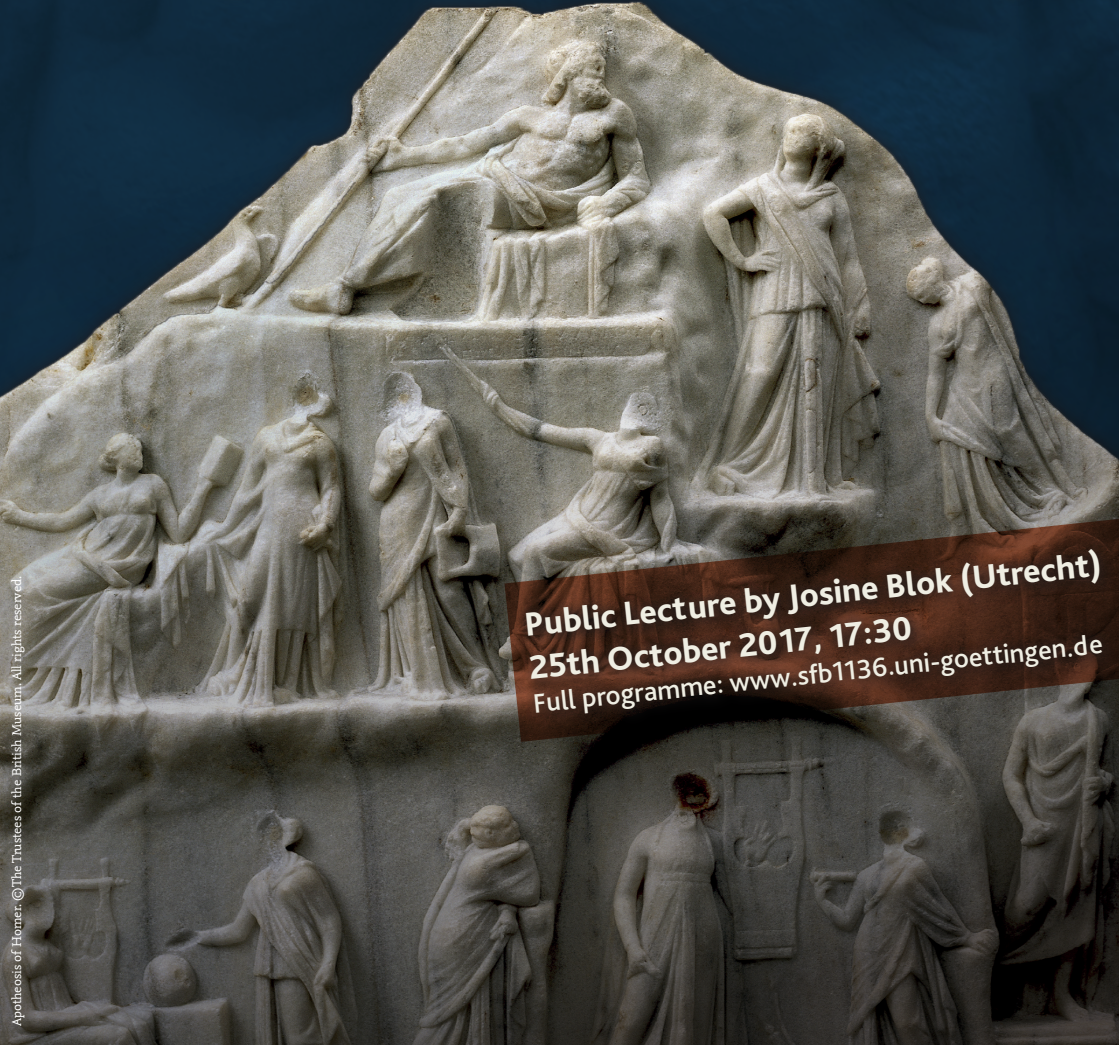

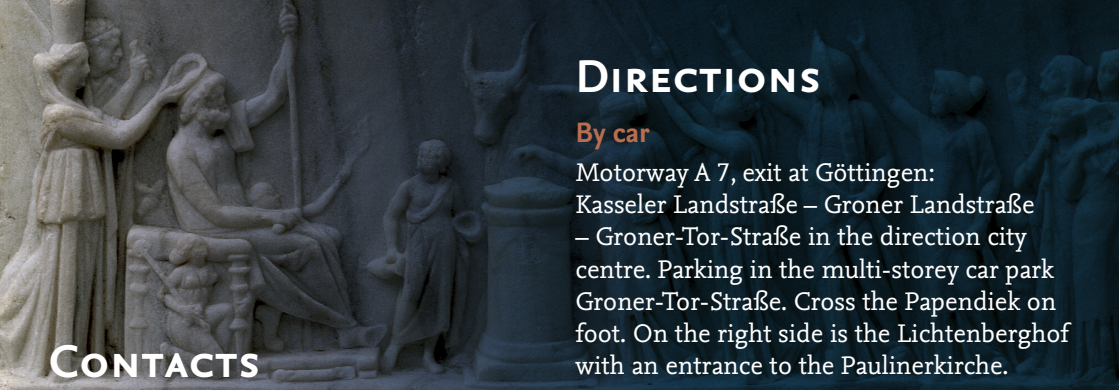

On foot from the train station

8 minute walking from the main train
station. Exit the station towards City Centre
and walk to the right. Cross the square
in the direction of the Bus Terminal, and
cross Berliner Straße at the pedestrian
crossing with traffic lights. Walk straight
on along Goethe Allee, which merges
into Prinzenstraße. The Paulinerkirche is
located at the corner of Prinzenstraße and
Papendiek, on the banks of the Leinekanal.
