General Requirements:

 - Yellow Ribbon: Keynotes and Lectures
 - Purple Ribbon: Social events
- Please make sure that the screen name you use in the Zoom sessions is the name you have registered with for the IVAC Festival!

Your Reflection Portfolio:

- Write a short report (1 to 3 pages) where you reflect your intercultural experience and answer the following key questions:
 - 1. What?**

What are some new perspectives that you engaged with? What are some blind spots in your own thinking that you have uncovered?
 - 2. So what?**

What about these new perspectives or uncovered blind spots struck you as particularly interesting and relevant for your studies/teaching? And why?
 - 3. Now what?**

What impact will these new perspectives or uncovered blind spots have on how you interact with peers/students in international (virtual) collaborations? What impact will they have on how you interact with your peers/students in local classroom settings?
- **Formatting guidelines for the body text:**
 - Fonts: Times New Roman (12pt) or Arial (11pt)
 - Line spacing: 1.5 lines, justified and automatic syllabification
